We're renewing tram tracks and overhead wires on St Georges Road in Fitzroy North.

Your journey may be affected during the works, so please plan ahead, consider alternative travel options and where possible, avoid the work zone area.

	Pedestrians Street closures and detours will be in place around the work zone. We recommend avoiding the area where possible.

Pedestrian access

During works, road closures and detours apply on St Georges Road, and some nearby cross streets. Pedestrian access around the work zone will be limited. Please follow signage around the work zone to access available pedestrian crossings.

Pedestrian crossings around the work zone are located at:

- Scotchmer Street
- Holden Street
- Eunsun Avenue

The following streets will be closed at St Georges Road:

Sunday 25 November

- Park Street

Sunday 25 November to Wednesday 28 November

- Miller Street
- Elizabeth Street
- Charles Street

You can access Elizabeth and Charles streets via Eunsun Avenue.

Thursday 29 November to Friday 30 November

- Miller Street

Connect with the tram replacement buses from temporary stops near Stop 26 Clarke St (up to 280m / 4 min walk).

Stop 25 Miller St

Connect with **Route 96** trams in Nicholson Street (up to 750m / 10 min walk).

Connect with tram replacement bus from temporary bus stops near Stop 22 Scotchmer St or Stop 26 Clarke St (up to 500m / 6 min walk), or

Connect with the tram replacement buses from Stop 22 Scotchmer St (up to 250m / 3 min walk).

Stop 23 Park St

Connect with the tram replacement buses from Stop 22 Scotchmer St (up to 250m / 3 min walk).

Stop 24 Holden St

Connect with **Route 96** trams in Nicholson Street (up to 750m / 10 min walk).

Connect with tram replacement bus from temporary bus stops near Stop 22 Scotchmer St or Stop 26 Clarke St (up to 500m / 6 min walk), or

Connect with the tram replacement buses from Stop 22 Scotchmer St (up to 250m / 3 min walk).

Alternative travel options

Replacement buses are low-floor where available. If you need assistance, please speak to our customer service team or alert your driver.

Mernda line trains between Merri and Thornbury stations.

Local bus routes **506** or **508** to connect.

Route 86 trams along Smith Street, Queens Parade and High Street or

Route 96 trams along Nicholson Street.

Traffic congestion is expected due to works and may cause delays to buses and other local tram routes. Allow up to 30 minutes extra journey time.

Tram service changes – Route 11

This map illustrates the proposed tram service changes for Route 11 in Melbourne, Victoria, effective from Thursday 29 November. The map shows the city grid with various streets and landmarks. Key features include:
