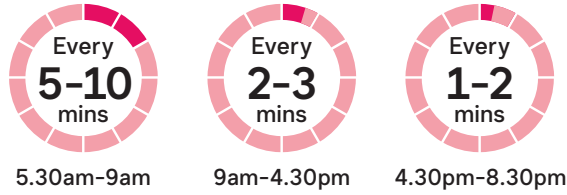
## Extra services

Grand Prix – Thursday 14 March  
to Sunday 17 March

### Gates 1, 2 and 3

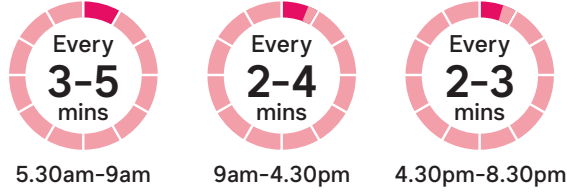
Extra trams run between Southern Cross Station and Gates 1 and 2 on Thursday and Friday. Catch **Route 12** trams for Gate 3.

On the weekend, high frequency Grand Prix shuttle trams run express between Southern Cross Station and Gates 1 and 2. Extra trams run between Southern Cross Station and Gate 3, running express between Southern Cross Station and City Road.



### Gates 5, 8, 9 and 10

St Kilda Road trams run normally on Thursday and Friday. Catch any tram (except **Route 1**) to get to your gate. High frequency Grand Prix shuttle trams run between Melbourne Central Station and Gates 5, 8, 9 and 10 via Swanston Street and St Kilda Road on the weekend.

## Service changes

Saturday 16 March and Sunday 17 March

- Service changes apply to Swanston Street/ St Kilda Road trams until 8.30pm each day.  
Trams run in sections or terminate before their usual destinations to service areas of high demand. Passengers can connect via high frequency Grand Prix shuttle trams.  
Service changes also apply to routes **12, 30, 86, 109** and **City Circle** trams.
- Buses replace **Route 96** trams between Bourke Street near William Street, and Canterbury Road at Fitzroy Street in St Kilda.
- Grand Prix express buses run between the Casino/MCEC and Gates 1, 2 and 3.  
Plan your journey and allow extra travel time.

### First tram to 8.30pm each day

#### Swanston Street and St Kilda Road

ROUTE 1 & 6	Trams run in sections, with no trams between RMIT University and Stop 17 Sturt St/Southbank Blvd or High Street near St Kilda Road. Take Grand Prix shuttle trams to connect.
ROUTE 3a & 16	No trams run between Melbourne University and Stop 32 Havelock St near Luna Park. Take Grand Prix Luna Park shuttle trams to connect.
ROUTE 5, 64 & 72	No trams run between Melbourne University and Chapel Street/Dandenong Road or Commercial Road near St Kilda Road. Take Grand Prix shuttle trams to connect.

#### Collins Street

ROUTE 12	Trams run express – Stop 124 Batman Park and Stop 124A Casino/MCEC not serviced.

#### La Trobe Street

ROUTE 30	No trams between Stop 1 Spencer St and Docklands.
City Circle	Trams won't service Stop 119 Spencer St and Stop D2 Central Pier.

### From 5.30am to 8.30pm each day

#### Bourke Street

ROUTE 86	No trams run between Southern Cross Station and Waterfront City Docklands. Consider <b>Route 11, 48, 70, 75</b> or <b>City Circle</b> trams.
ROUTE 96	Buses replace trams between Bourke Street near William Street, and Canterbury Road at Fitzroy Street. No trams run in Acland Street.

### From 6am to 8.30pm each day

#### Collins Street

ROUTE 109	Trams run express – Stop 124 Batman Park, Stop 124A Casino/MCEC and Stop 125 Clarendon St Junction not serviced.

### From 7am to 8.30pm each day

#### Swanston Street and St Kilda Road

ROUTE 67	No trams run between Melbourne University and Stop 30 St Kilda Junction. Take Grand Prix shuttle trams to connect.
