# TRAM NETWORK UPGRADE

## St Kilda Junction substation façade installation

Public Transport Victoria (PTV) in partnership with Yarra Trams will soon commence construction of the facade around the St Kilda Junction substation.

The first stage of these construction activities will be the installation of footings for the façade structure.

## Major works



Works will involve excavation and the installation of footings for the façade structure adjacent to the substation building. Due to the close proximity of the substation to the tram tracks, some night work is required to avoid tram services.

The façade structure and finishes are being fabricated offsite. Works attaching the facade structure to the footings and around the substation are scheduled to commence in June. Further notification will be provided about this activity closer to the date.

Landscaping will also be installed to finish the facade treatment.

#### **Pedestrians**



The work site will be fenced off for safety, however footpaths will remain open around the work area to allow pedestrian access to businesses and residences located around the work zone.

Please ensure you follow any signage around the work area.

Night works will involve activity outside the fenced area on the eastern perimeter of the substation and will be safely managed by contractors.







#### **Motorists**



Road closures are not required, however localised traffic management will be in place when machinery and equipment is entering or leaving the site.

Motorists are asked to heed signage and follow the direction of traffic controllers and workers as required.

#### Noise and dust



Associated noise and dust from machinery, vehicles and work crews is unavoidable but Yarra Trams will do all we can to keep this to a minimum.

### Public transport changes



There will be no impacts to tram services during these works.

## Local community



Access to shops and local infrastructure will remain unchanged during the works. Yarra Trams encourages you to allow some extra time when moving around the area while work is being done.

As this work is necessary to maintain a safe tram network as required by the *Rail Management Act* 1996 (Vic), Yarra Trams will not compensate any third parties for any losses incurred during the project.
