ROUTE 96 – TRAM WORKS



Public Transport Victoria (PTV) and Yarra Trams are undertaking preliminary works now to facilitate the installation of new accessible tram stops in January 2020.

Due to some delays to works at previous stops, works at Stop 20 - Richardson Street, Fitzroy North are anticipated to begin on **Wednesday 25 September**. Our teams will spend about two weeks at Stop 20 before moving to the future location of Stop 18 - Fenwick Street, Fitzroy North.

The majority of works will be completed Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm. If night works are required, we will provide advance notice.

The works will involve

- Setting up the work area and traffic management.
- Removing the bluestone gutter.
- Installing new cables, poles and drainage.
- Creating accessible pedestrian ramps.
- Reinstating the work area for use between these works and major works in January 2020.

What to expect

- Medium levels of noise with some short periods of high noise levels.
- Access to shops and businesses will be maintained. Please continue to support these businesses during the work.
- Temporary access restrictions to some properties is required; we will notify these residents.
- Two lanes reduced to one and on street parking closed in limited sections.
- Pedestrian detours around works.
- Route 96 trams and bus services will run as usual.

Please follow signage and traffic management around the work zone and allow extra time when planning your journey.

Works are dependent on weather and subject to change. We appreciate your patience while we complete these works.
