St Kilda Festival special event services



We've organised more tram services to get you to and from St Kilda Festival, with extra trams running between St Kilda and the city. Service changes apply due to road closures during the festival.

From first to last tram

ROUTE 3a	Trams run between East Malvern and Stop 32 Havelock St near Luna Park. Take Route 16, 64 or 67 to connect to Melbourne University.
ROUTE 12	Trams run between Stop 122 Southern Cross Station and St Kilda. Take Route 109 trams to connect to Victoria Parade and Collins Street.
ROUTE 16	Trams run in sections, with no trams between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and Stop 32 Havelock St near Luna Park.

From 4.30am to last tram

ROUTE 96	Trams run between East Brunswick and Stop 132 St Kilda Station, with extra trams running between Stop 10 Parliament Station and St Kilda Station.

ROUTE 67	Extra trams will run, with every second service running between Melbourne University and Stop 38 Brunning St.

ROUTE 5	Trams run between Malvern and Stop 38 Orrong Road. Take Route 64 to continue your journey.
