

# TRAM WORKS

## Route 57: Abbotsford, Queensberry, Errol and Victoria streets, North Melbourne

Public Transport Victoria (PTV) and Yarra Trams are upgrading the tram power supply network in North Melbourne. Earlier this year we installed new poles. During May we will install conduits and other power infrastructure along Abbotsford, Queensberry, Errol and Victoria streets, North Melbourne. Expect noise, temporary lane and road closures, some traffic detours and buses replacing trams during the main works.

# Stage one

24-hour works from 9pm Sunday 2 May to 5am Wednesday 5 May 2021

## Works

- The work will include:
  - Setting up work areas and traffic management.
  - Trenching and installing conduits, pits and other power infrastructure within the tram way at key locations (refer to map).
  - Installation of conduits and power infrastructure from tram line to pole at the corner of Victoria Street and Elizabeth Street.
  - Reinstatement of the tram surface.

## Road and parking

- From 9pm Sunday 2 May to 5am Wednesday 5 May 2021:
  - Victoria Street will be closed to traffic between Peel Street and Elizabeth Street (refer map).
  - Abbotsford Street will be closed to traffic heading south on the the corner of Molesworth Street (refer map).
  - Abbotsford Street will be closed to traffic heading south on the corner of O'Shannassy Street (refer map).
  - Abbotsford Street will be closed to traffic heading north on the corner of Queensberry Street (refer map).
  - Queensberry Street will be closed to traffic heading east on the corner of Errol Street (refer map).
  - Some on street car parking may be temporarily closed near work areas.

Traffic management and signage will direct traffic, please follow signage around works.

## Public transport

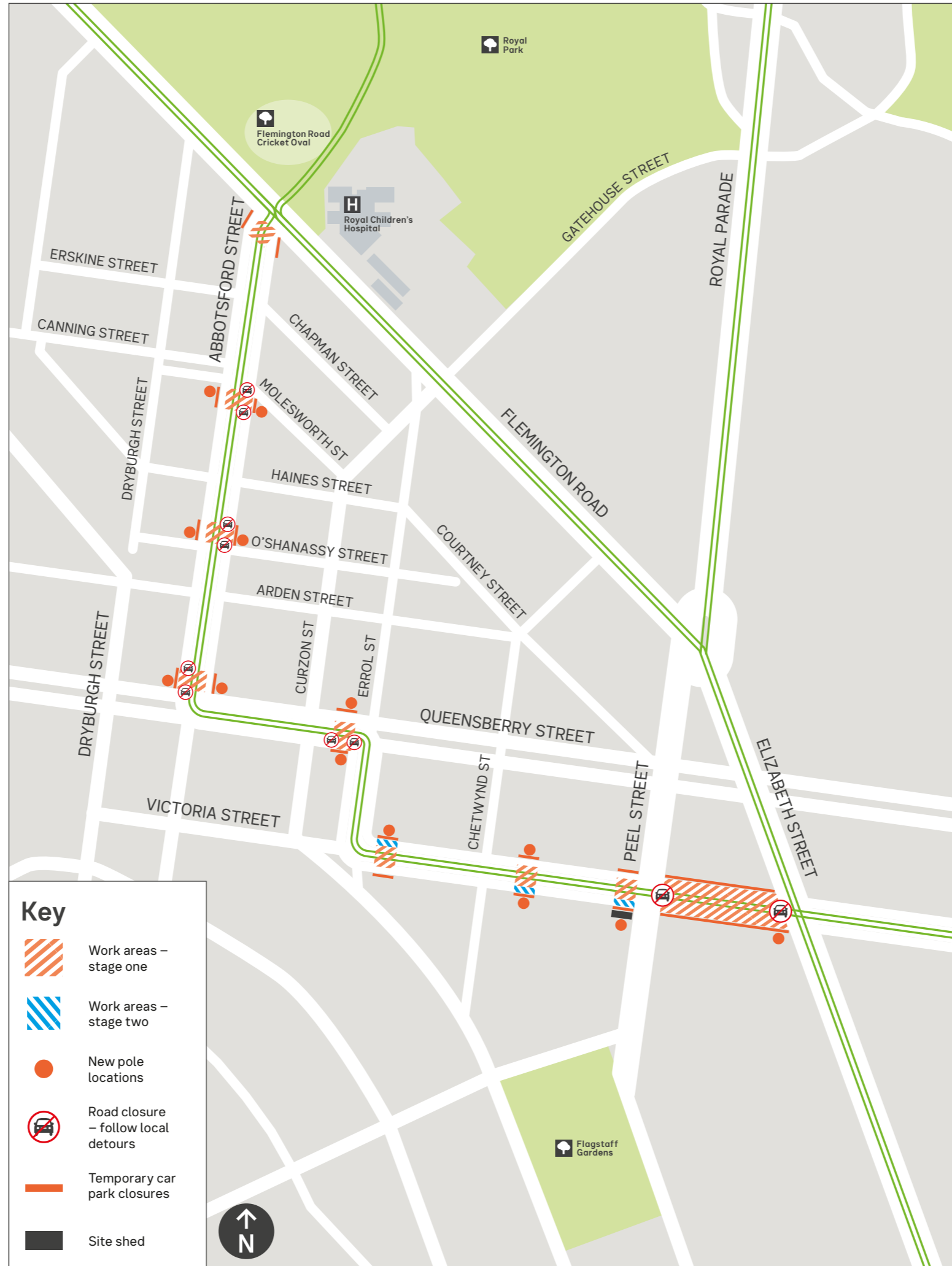
- Buses will replace Route 57 tram services from Monday 3 May to Tuesday 4 May, first to last tram.

## Pedestrians

- There may be temporary footpath closures with localised detours in place. Please observe and follow traffic management.

## Noise and dust

- Medium-to-high level noise and low-to-medium level dust can be expected.
- Where possible noisiest work will be between 6am and 10pm.



# Stage two

9pm to 6am, Wednesday 5 May to Sunday 16 May 2021 (no work Friday or Saturday nights)

## Works

- The work will include:
  - Progressively setting up work area and traffic management (not all work areas will be attended each night).
  - Trenching and installing conduits under the road from the tram way to the new poles.
  - Reinstatement of the tram surface.

## Road and parking

- Temporary lane closures near other work areas, but no roads will be closed.
- Some on street car parking may be temporarily closed.
- Please observe and follow construction signs and traffic management.

## Public transport

- No changes to Route 57 tram services.

## Pedestrians

- There may be temporary footpath closures with localised detours in place. Please observe and follow traffic management.

## Noise and dust

- Medium-to-high level noise and low-to-medium level dust can be expected.

## Open for business

- Businesses will be open during the works and will be accessible via footpaths. Please continue to support local businesses during these essential tram works.

# Close out works

Once the tram infrastructure, including power conduits are in place, the team will install power cables. Dates and time for this work will be provided closer to the time.
