

Getting around Swan Street

last tram Friday 18 February

Swan Street will be closed between Stanley and Stawell streets and the work zone will be fenced off for safety.

Footpaths remain open on both sides, but access to the other side of the street will be limited.



From 10am to 6pm daily

Our customer service team will be at Church, Coppin and Burnley streets to assist you with accessible options such as electric wheelchair, trio bike and taxi-on-demand services (to operate on side streets). Please follow signage and speak to the team if you need assistance getting around the work zone.

Call **1800 800 007** to find out your options if you have specific accessibility requirements.


For accessible journeys, passengers are encouraged to connect using trains between Richmond and Hawthorn stations.
