TRAM IMPROVEMENT WORK

Southbank Tram Depot Entrances and Stop 125a, Southbank Thursday 10 August to Monday 14 August 2017

As part of the modernisation of Melbourne's tram network, Yarra Trams and Public Transport Victoria are improving the 125a tram stop and entrances to Southbank Depot.

Preliminary work has commenced and involves deliveries and site preperation. Major work will occur at:

- 125a tram stop under the overpass at the southern side of Normanby Road, opposite the entrance to the Melbourne Convention and Entertainment Centre.
- East entrance Southbank Depot
- West entrance Southbank Depot

Major work starts at 12:01 am Thursday 10 August and will continue 24 hours a day until 5am Monday 14 August 2017.

Traffic will be managed to prepare the area. For major work, a partial road closure will be in place from 12am Thursday 10 August until 5am Monday 14 August 2017.

• Normanby Road will have one lane closed on the southern side, opposite MCEC.

Traffic controllers will direct traffic and help facilitate local access where needed.

The work zone will be fenced off for safety. During the project access to pedestrian and bike paths around stop 125a and stop 126 will change. Signage will direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative paths.



Route 96, 109 services will be affected.

Services will operate as 96a and 109a. Both Route 96a and 109a will terminate at Stop 125 Claredon Street, Southbank.

Buses will replace:

- Route 109 tram services between Stop 125 Clarendon Street Junction, Southbank and Port Melbourne.
- Route 96 tram services between Stop 125 Claredon Street Junction, Southbank and Stop 132 St Kilda Station.

The noisiest work will occur between 6am and 10pm; however there may be a need to conduct noisy work outside these hours to ensure that the work is completed by 5am Monday 14 August 2017.

Businesses in the area will continue trading as normal. The Colonial Tramcar restaurant will leave from Peel Street at the Queen Victoria Market during the works. Yarra Trams encourages you to continue to show your support for local traders during this time.

As this work is necessary to maintain a safe tram network as required by the Rail Safety Act 2006 (Vic), Yarra Trams will not compensate any third parties for any losses incurred during the project.



Stop 125a will be upgraded to a level access tram stop, providing pedestrian priority and safe access to the local area. A new stop shelter will incorporate improved lighting and furniture.

Tracks and overhead lines at the depot were last renewed 21 years ago and require renewal. This new infrastructure will improve operational efficiency for the depot, reduce the chance of derailments and create a smoother surface for cyclists and tram passengers.
