

IMPORTANT REMINDER FOR RESIDENTS AND TRADERS

Major Redevelopment of Domain Interchange Good Friday 29 March to Friday 12 April 2013



Dear Resident/Trader,

As previously advised, preliminary works are taking place at Domain Interchange ahead of the major redevelopment of this tram stop commencing on Good Friday 29 March 2013.

In order to minimise the disruption to morning services and traffic, some of these works need to occur after 10pm and will involve the use of some noisy equipment.

The final stage of pre-works on overhead infrastructure will be conducted on Tuesday 26, Wednesday 27 and Thursday 28 March, between the last and the first scheduled tram service each day.

While we will continue to make every effort to minimise the noise caused during the remainder of these preliminary works, the presence of unforeseen objects under the road surface may require the use of loud tools and equipment. Some loud drilling will also occur on the night of Thursday 28 March as our teams install some infrastructure items at the site.

Please note that the use of vehicle reversing beepers and flashing lights is a safety requirement and these devices cannot be switched off.

These pre-works are an essential part of the **major Domain Interchange redevelopment**, scheduled to occur from **Good Friday 29 March to Friday 12 April**.

This important upgrade will facilitate improved and safer access to tram services for passengers, with the addition of two double-sided, level access stops and a dedicated tram track for Route 8 services to Toorak turning into Domain Road. The installation of new tracks and widening the radius of the curve between St Kilda Road and Park Street will reduce tram noise. Other improvements include additional pedestrian crossings and new dedicated bicycle lanes on St Kilda Road.

The **major works** will be carried out in **two stages**, as outlined in the table below:

Stage	Date & Time	Traffic management	Noise level	Nature of works
1: Major works (5 days)	12am Friday 29 March to 12am Wednesday 3 April (24 hours a day)	Full road closure , detours in place. All footpaths will remain open during the works to ensure pedestrians access to all businesses and properties. Traffic controllers on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians.	High to very high	Removal of existing shelters, cutting of existing rail & saw cutting of concrete. Breaking out and removal of concrete and existing rail, including loading of broken concrete onto trucks. Construction of new tracks, pavements, overhead infrastructure and traffic signals.
2: Major works (9 days)	12am Wednesday 3 April to 5am Friday 12 April (24 hours a day)	Partial road closures including Domain Rd and Park St (2 lanes south/north bound). Traffic controllers on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians.	High	Construction of platform stops, overhead infrastructure and traffic signals. Asphalting and road works.

Tram service changes - Good Friday 29 March to Thursday 11 April

Route 8 trams will operate as **8a**. Services to Toorak will terminate at Stop 19 Dorcas St. Services to Moreland will terminate at a temporary stop in Domain Rd near St Kilda Rd.

Routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67 and 72 trams will operate as **Routes 3a, 5a, 6a, 16a, 64a, 67a and 72a**. Services from the city will terminate at Stop 19 Dorcas St. Services to the city will terminate at Stop 21 Bowen Cr.

Route 55 trams will terminate at Stop 119 Park St.

Route 1 will operate normally.

Passengers can walk around the outside of the works zone to connect between services. During this time, trams will operate to the normal service frequency, however they may not arrive at the scheduled time.
