

Tram network upgrade

Domain and St Kilda roads, Melbourne

June 2025

Update 2

The Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) and Yarra Trams regularly carry out maintenance and upgrade work across the network to improve operations and passenger experience.

As a result of the completion of Anzac Station, we will reconfigure and reinstate overhead tram wires and associated infrastructure at the intersection of Domain and St Kilda roads.

Part of Domain and St Kilda roads will have disruptions from Sunday 8 June, including full road closures of parts of Domain and St Kilda roads from 9pm, Friday 13 June to 4am, Monday 16 June 2025.

7am to 5pm, Monday 28 April to Friday 2 May 2025 – **Completed**

9pm to 7am, Sunday 8 June to Friday 13 June 2025

- Setting up the work area including site offices and traffic management.
- Preparing poles for the installation of new overhead wires.
- Hauling underground tram power cables.
- Setting up site sheds.

Road and parking



9pm to 7am, Sunday 8 June to Friday 13 June 2025

- Domain Road will be closed to vehicle traffic, and will be bollarded off for safety.
- Mostly low levels of noise.
- Vehicles, trucks, machinery and contractors on site.
- Access to properties will not be affected by the works.
- Footpaths will remain open, temporary detours may be in place at some times.
- Traffic management and signage will direct traffic. Please follow signage around works.

No changes to tram services.

Pedestrians



Footpaths will be open. Temporary detours may be in place. Please follow signage around works.

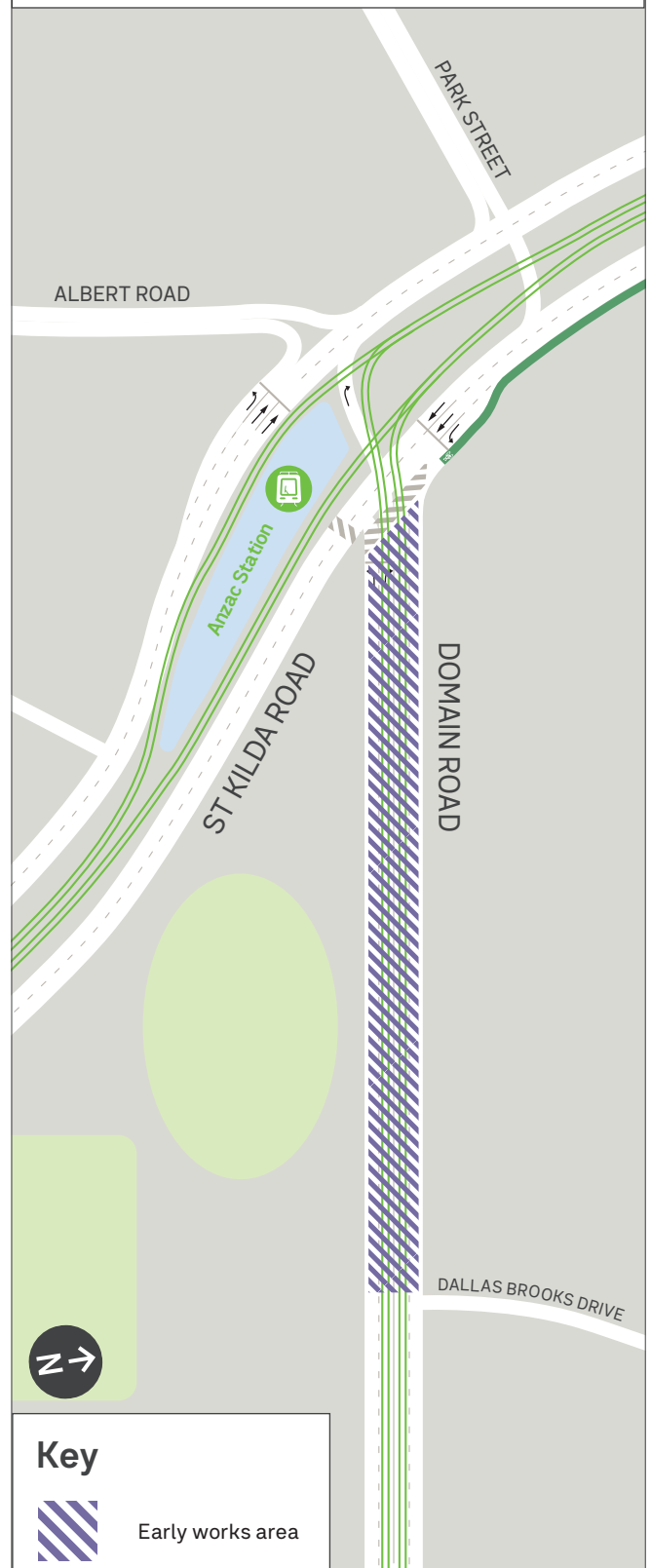
Noise and dust

9pm to 7am, Sunday 8 June to Friday 13 June 2025

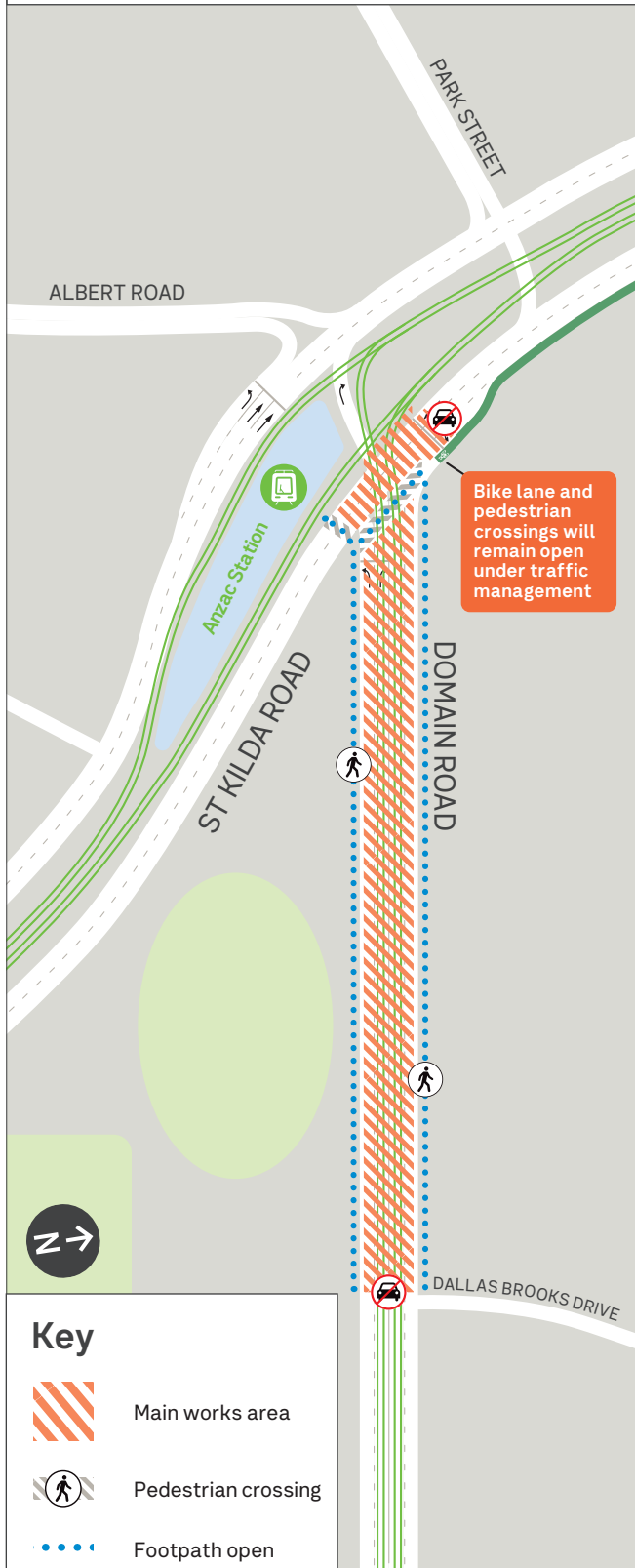

- Setting up site and traffic management, including bollards bordering the perimeter of the site.
- Installation of new overhead tram wires in Domain Road.
- Installation of new and reconfiguring overhead tram wires at the intersection of Domain and St Kilda roads.
- Reinstating the site.

Road and parking



- Domain Road, between Dallas Brooks Drive and St Kilda Road will be closed throughout the major works.
- Southbound St Kilda Road at the intersection of Domain Road will be closed to vehicle traffic with detours in place.
- The southbound bike lane on St Kilda Road will remain open under traffic management.
- Mostly low levels of noise.
- Vehicles, trucks, machinery and contractors on site.
- Footpaths will remain open, temporary detours may be in place at some times.
- Traffic management and signage will direct traffic. Please follow signage around works.
- **Emergency services will be allowed access.**

Public transport



Buses will replace trams on some sections of routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67 and 72 on St Kilda Road.

About the project

Yarra Trams is working with the Department of Transport and Planning and City of Melbourne to reconfigure and reinstate overhead tram wires to Domain Road. This will include works at the intersection of Domain and St Kilda roads.

These works are now able to proceed with the completion of Anzac Station.

The project includes:

- Current pole dressing and preparation
- Overhead power installation
- Underground power pre works
- Underground power installation.

There will be no changes to the final traffic and parking arrangements after the works are completed.
