



Notice of works

September 2025

The Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) and Yarra Trams are upgrading the Brunswick Tram Depot to support the addition of larger trams to the fleet, more trams in the depot and provide improved accessibility and safety. These upgrade works have been ongoing since last year and are progressing well.

In the coming months we will remove the existing scaffolding installed in July, undertake service proving works to locate underground services and install poles to support overhead tram wires.

For safety, these works can only be done late at night when trams are not operating and traffic volume is low.

Where?

- Scaffold removal works will happen on Sydney Road, at the front of the Brunswick Depot building.
- Service proving works will happen at the corner of Moreland Road and Cameron Street.
- Pole installation works will happen along Sydney Road, Moreland Road and Cameron Street.

When?

- Scaffold removal from 1am to 4am, Monday 15 to Wednesday 17 September 2025 (Nightly).
- Service Proving from 1am to 4am, one night in September. Date to be confirmed.
- Pole installation from 1am to 4am, up to 10 nights in October and November 2025. We will confirm the dates closer to works and will provide advance notification.

What to expect?

- Vehicles, machinery, mobile cranes and contractors on site.
- Mostly low to medium levels of noise. Some short periods of high levels of noise.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Footpaths will remain open, but their width will be reduced. Some detours in place as required for safety.
- Please follow signage and traffic management around the work zone and allow extra time when planning your journey.
- Works are dependent on weather and ground conditions and subject to change. We appreciate your patience while these works are completed.
