Brunswick Tram Depot Upgrade works

July 2026

We're in the final stages of upgrading the Brunswick Tram Depot as we add larger trams and improve how the network operates.

Works will continue around the Brunswick Tram Depot precinct in July including site investigations and connecting underground services. We'll also start constructing a new tram terminus track along Cameron Street.

Sydney Road civil works

We're continuing to construct and upgrade power supplies and underground services along Sydney Road near the Brunswick Tram Depot. We're also installing parking signs and traffic signalling infrastructure.

When?

- **7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturdays until Friday 7 August** to build and upgrade services.
- Sydney Road will be open to traffic.

What to expect?

- There will be temporary lane, car park and footpath closures on Sydney Road near Donald Street at various times.
- Medium to high levels of noise at times during our day works from **Saturday 4 July to Friday 7 August** including saw cutting and deep excavation works.
- There will be no impact to buses.

Cameron Street service relocations

We are relocating gas and water services on Cameron Street.

When?

- **7am to 5pm, Monday 6 July to Friday 10 July**

What to expect?

- Access to Peveril Street from Cameron Street will be closed.

- Access into Peveril Street will be via Sydney Road.
- Right-hand turns onto Cameron Street from Peveril Street will remain open.
- There will be no impact to buses or trams.

Cameron Street out of hours works

From Monday 13 July, we start out of hours works to continue constructing a new tram terminus track along Cameron Street.

When?

- **Weeknights, 6pm to 7am, Monday 13 July to Monday 10 August**
- **Saturdays, 7am to 5pm**

What to expect?

- Cameron Street will continue to be closed between Peveril Street and Prowse Street.
- Cameron Street will be closed between Moreland Road and Prowse Street between **Monday 20 July and Monday 10 August**. Vehicles will not be able to turn into Cameron Street from Moreland Road during this time.
- Access to Cameron Street will be via Cozens and Peveril streets during this time.
- Mostly medium to high levels of noise during deep excavation and saw cutting.
- There will be no impact to buses or trams.
- We will aim to complete our most disruptive works before 10pm.

Emergency services access will be maintained throughout all of our works.

We will work directly with businesses regarding access requirements.

Moreland Road site investigations

We are completing site investigations in the area to help us safely design and build underground power cables that will connect the new Brunswick Depot Substation to the network.

When?

- 9pm to 7am, Thursday 23 July and Friday 24 July.

What to expect?

- There will be temporary lane and car park closures on Moreland Road near Moreland Train Station.
- Mostly medium to high levels of noise at times including saw cutting.
- There will be no impact to buses or trams.
