



Tram network upgrade

Plenty Road and Tyler Street Preston

June 2025 Update 1

We're making safety improvements at the Plenty Road and Tyler Street intersection and returning the northbound tram stop 52 to a new location north of the intersection near Frier Avenue.

Our works will make traffic lanes more consistent along Plenty Road and improve safety for pedestrians.

Northbound tram stop 52 will be operational after the works are complete.

To deliver these works safely, the intersection of Plenty Road and Tyler Street will be closed to traffic for one day from 9am, Monday 30 June to 3am, Tuesday 1 July. Buses will replace trams on Route 86 during this time.

Noise and dust



Some noise and dust are unavoidable, but we will work to minimise this as much as possible. Most activity will be medium level noise, with some periods of high level noise when saw cutting and excavating.

Re-sheeting will involve high to medium levels of noise.
